Program Requirements

How to enroll

Enrollment in the Summer Focus program is restricted to:

1. Rising high school juniors and seniors.
2. Students with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
3. Students who can demonstrate strong English skills.

Registering is as easy as 1, 2, 3...

1. Submit an application online or email us and pay a program deposit of \$1,495 to reserve a spot.
2. Submit your enrollment paperwork:
 - A copy of the student's most recent school transcripts
 - A writing sample in the form of a letter of interest, written by the student, no more than 500 words, covering the following:
 - What in your academic background (AP classes, test results, classroom participation, study habits, etc.) prepares you to participate in this program?
 - How will you benefit from this program? How will it prepare you for future career plans, leadership opportunities, etc.?
 - What is something else about yourself that helps balance your academic life?
 - If for any reason your application is not accepted your deposit will be returned in full. You may also submit your enrollment paperwork before applying and be pre-approved.
3. Select your courses, sign the medical release/rules form, and pay the remainder of your tuition.
4. Education Unlimited will take care of all registration, enrollment, housing, and meal arrangements.

Summer Focus at UC Berkeley is commonly known as a 'pre-college summer program' or 'summer study program,' but what you need to know is that this program effectively combines learning with summer adventures and excursions, so that you truly get a feel for college before having to make the important decision of which college to choose.
